Great value and environmentally friendly - travel by train to Freiburg with Deutsche Bahn.

Reserve your overnight stay in Freiburg together with your train tickets. With Rail Inclusive Tours (RIT) rail tickets to Freiburg start from just €57.00 per person (with the BahnCard, not including the hotel of your choice).

Decide yourself whether you want to travel in first or second class. The prices are divided into two kilometre zones – please refer to the table below for further information. Prices depend on the length of the rail journey from your departure station to Freiburg im Breisgau. You are permitted to use all of the standard DB trains with the exception of DB car trains (Autozug), chartered trains (Sonderzug) and the Metropolitan and InterConnex services. Reservation and the payment of a surcharge is required for travel on ICE Sprinter trains and the the City Night Line service.

Ticket Validity:

Please make sure you make your seat reservation in advance at your local DB accredited travel agency or at your local railway station. We regret that the Freiburg Insider Group AG is not able to make seat reservations. The terms and conditions of Deutsche Bahn AG apply to your reservation. Holders of BahnCards please note: please do not forget to bring your BahnCard with you on your journey. And particularly important: remember to have your written hotel reservation at hand in the train as your ticket is only valid if you are able to provide proof of your overnight stay.

RIT tickets apply to return tickets valid on all standard Deutsche Bahn AG trains (incl. ICE and EC/IC trains). They are not valid on DB car trains (Autozug), charter trains (Sonderzug) or on the InterConnex service. Within Germany, RIT tickets are valid for one month subsequent to their first day of validity. Outward and return tickets are valid for 2 days subsequent to the start of the journey. The return journey may only

commence one day after the outward journey. Stopovers during journeys are permitted. Outward and return journeys must be completed via the standard routes or those stated in the timetable to the destination or home railway station. RIT tickets which are purchased and have expired cannot be exchanged.

Children aged from 6-14 years travel free of charge when accompanied by at least one parent or grandparent. Children aged up to and including 5 years travel free of charge.

A surcharge of EUR 15.00 for 1st class and EUR 10.00 for 2nd class is payable per person for the use of the ICE Sprinter service in each direction of travel. This surcharge includes the reservation fee for the use of the ICE Sprinter service.
