

Invitation To A Home stay In Matsuyama

Home stay

The Matsuyama International Center (MIC) will find host families for foreign nationals interested in goodwill exchange and in deepening their understanding of Japan by staying with Japanese families.

The length of the home stay is usually a few days up to a few weeks. However, if you wish to stay longer, please speak with MIC

Goals of the Program

To provide foreign nationals visiting Matsuyama with the opportunity to experience life in a Japanese household and to promote understanding of Japan. To provide the participating host families with the opportunity to broaden their own horizons and to promote international understanding by hosting a foreign guest.

How To Apply

Applicants interested in participating in our home stay program in the Matsuyama area should contact MIC first.

MIC will send you an application form and an explanation. To apply, fill out the form and mail or fax or e-mail it to MIC at least one month prior to the date you wish to have a home stay.

Please Note

1. This is a program aiming to promote cross-cultural interaction and goodwill exchange between foreign nationals and Japanese families. It should not be used for the purpose of receiving free accommodation and meals.
2. The host families offer accommodation and meals at home free of charge on a volunteer basis. The participants, however, are responsible for their personal expenses, such as transportation, telephone calls, and sightseeing costs.
3. In the unlikely event of an accident occurring during the home stay period, neither MIC nor the host family will bear any responsibility. Therefore, we advise the applicant to take out travel and medical insurance.
